

AWARDS FOR YOU AND YOUR CLUB!!

TROPHIES – Awarded to all 4-H members with **\$300 or more** in sales. They will be awarded according to the amount sold. Each hundred will constitute a trophy group.

GRADUAL COMMISSION – 4-Hers selling **\$300-\$1499** will receive a 5% commission, 4-Hers selling **\$1500 and over** will receive a 10% commission.

EDGAR GRANT TRAVEL TROPHY – Awarded to the member selling the highest dollar volume.

JUNIOR SPONSORSHIP AWARD – Awarded to a **JUNIOR** member selling the **most clover sponsorships** but selling **under \$300**.

HIGH SPONSORSHIP SALESPERSON TROPHIES – The **JUNIOR** selling the **most clover sponsorships** will receive the **Junior Sponsorship Travel Trophy**, plus a first place trophy. The **SENIOR** selling the **most clover sponsorships** will receive the **Senior Sponsorship Travel Trophy** plus a first place trophy.

HIGH BOOSTER SALESPERSON TROPHY – The 4-Her (7-19) selling the most **white sponsorships** will receive this travel trophy plus a first place trophy.

HIGH PATRON SALESPERSON TROPHY – The 4-Her (7-19) selling the most **green sponsorships** will receive this travel trophy plus a first place trophy.

CLUB AWARDS

100% CLUBS – Each member of a club must turn in at least **FOUR** sales forms and return them under his/her own name. Awards vary according to years with 100% sales. Banners, flags, poles, etc. Your clubs name will be displayed at the fair.

TRAVEL PLAQUE – Will be awarded to the Club selling the highest percentage based on the number of clover, white & green sponsorships.
