Terms and Conditions:

1. The business of the Lessee is to be conducted in accordance with all State and Local laws and the Hartford County 4-H Fair Association rules and regulations set forth in this contract.
2. Insurance coverage will be the responsibility of the Lessee.
3. Participating vendors shall indemnify and hold harmless the Hartford County 4-H Fair Association, the Town of Somers, and The University of Connecticut and its officials, employees, and agents as any and all liability, judgments, losses, settlements, costs or charges (including attorneys fee) incurred by the Hartford County 4-H Fair Association and any of its officials, employees, and agents as a result of any claim, demand of action or suit relating to any bodily injury (including death), loss, or property damage caused by, arising out of related to, or associated with the use of property or the participation of the vendor or by the vendor's employees, agents, or invitees in the 2017 Hartford County 4-H Fair.
4. Lessee must display, at all times, in full view, the prices charged for services. The concession shall be run in a publicly acceptable fashion. Lessee shall not change the position of the concession, or merchandise, or make any other changes without written permission from the Hartford County 4-H Fair Association.
5. Lessee shall not give money as prizes.
6. The Hartford County 4-H Fair Association reserves the right to inspect items for sale and to ban items deemed inappropriate for a 4-H Fair event. Anyone found to be violating the rules and regulations is subject to removal.
7. No cars or trucks will be allowed on the Fairgrounds during business hours of the Fair. Crafters will be granted one vehicle pass for set-up purposes, and will be expected to use only the designated entry/exit routes. All vehicles must be removed ½ hour before the fair opens and removed by 6:00 p.m. upon break-down.
8. All vendors must be set up by 9:00 a.m. and must remain open until 5:00 p.m. No concession shall be closed or dismantled during these business hours, unless written permission is obtained from the Fair Association.
9. Two (2) One-Day Crafter passes will be issued to each crafter. Additional Crafter Passes may be available for a fee.
10. The Hartford County 4-H Fair Association is not responsible for any losses or damages that may occur.
