HARTFORD COUNTY 4-H FAIR ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Hartford County 4-H Fair Association will award up to eight (8) two hundred dollar (\$200) scholarships for those continuing their education beyond high school.

PURPOSE

1. To recognize 4-H members and leaders who have exhibited outstanding leadership qualities in the 4-H Fair Association.
2. To provide financial assistance for these applicants.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Have completed at least three years in 4-H as a member or leader; youth must be current Hartford County 4-H members.
- Be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student in an institution of higher learning;
- Be entering the first or second year of study;
- Application must be postmarked by midnight on May 20 of the calendar year the form is distributed to the Hartford County 4-H Office, 1800 Asylum Avenue, West Hartford, CT 06117.
- Have participated in some way in Hartford County 4-H Fair Association activities.
- Be willing to appear before a selection committee for a personal interview, if requested;
- Be aware that applicants may apply a second year, but will only be eligible for available funds after first year applicant scholarships have been awarded.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Fair President will appoint a chairperson at least one month prior to the Fair and they together will choose a committee consisting of:

- Two (2) Advisors of the Fair Association
- Two (2) 4-H Alumni
- Two (2) Directors of the Fair Association
- One (1) County 4-H Staff (ex-officio)
